

ADULT EXHIBITOR STILL EXHIBITS DEPARTMENT

General Rules:

1. Ages 19 and older as of January 1st, 2019.
2. Entry forms are due by Friday – August 16th, 2019 Enter online at www.tbvfait.com or mail or drop entry forms and fees at the office.
3. Adult Exhibitors may not be a junior member of the 4-H or FFA organizations unless the class is not offered in the Junior Department.
4. Open to California and Oregon Residents.
5. No entry limit unless otherwise stated.
6. Items may not be entered in "Any Other" classes if there is a class offered for that item.
7. Care will be taken to ensure the safety of all items entered, but the fair shall not be responsible for any loss.
8. Any item unsuitable for display and not meeting exhibit requirements will be disqualified.
9. Items which must be hung for display must be ready to hang with sturdy hardware.
10. Exhibits must be accurately and correctly labeled, cleaned and pressed if needed.
11. Sweepstakes shall be awarded as specified based upon these scoring guidelines:
 - a. First award - 5 points; Second award - 3 points; Third award - 1 point.
 - b. Sweepstakes shall be awarded only when at least three separate exhibitors have achieved at least a combined point total of 30.
 - c. To receive sweepstakes awards, an exhibitor must have a minimum of ten points.
 - d. Sweepstakes points will be credited only to the exhibitor whose name appears on the entry form.
12. All divisions or classes will be judged under the American system and/or Danish system.

Contest Rules:

- Size no larger than 160" circumference (40"x40") any shape is acceptable – round, rectangle, square, ect.
- Must use each of the coordinating fabrics – any amount but must be visible.
- You may add TWO pieces of fabric of your choice
- Get creative – it is OK to embellish, quilt, paint, use buttons, beads, tread, yarn, ect.
- All entries must be clean and unscented, no cigarette odor or pet hair.
- Must have sleeve attached for hanging
- Label much be 4" x 4"; include name, address, phone & entry title on bottom right corner on the back side
- All entries will be returned by December 1, 2019.
- Prizes will be awarded to 1st place, (established by the judge) and viewer's choice.
- May enter as group or individual.
- Design may be original or purchased pattern, but you MUST give credit to the designer
