



Junior Fair Board Scholarship

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION:

A \$500 scholarship award will be presented during the annual Tulelake-Butte Valley Fair Awards Ceremony held at the fair on Sunday in Jock's Sale Pavilion. The scholarship funds will be released to the recipient with proof upon completion of one semester of college and having maintained a 2.5 grade point average (GPA).

ELIGIBILITY:

This scholarship is for graduating seniors with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA and two years involvement in the Tulelake-Butte Valley Fair in an exhibit (livestock or still) and/or competition and have been an active member of the TBVF Junior Fair Board for at least two years.

Residency: All contestants must reside in the 10-A District.

Age: Contestants must currently be a Senior.

GENERAL RULES:

Application: The application must be typed. All applications must be postmarked or hand delivered to the Tulelake-Butte Valley Fair Office, P.O. Box 866 Tulelake, CA 96134 no later than **August 1st**.

Transcripts: Please attach an unofficial school transcript.

Letter of Recommendation: Provide at least one letter of recommendation with application. You may submit more than one letter of recommendation.

Selection Process: Applications will be pre-screened. Judging and interviews will be held at the TBV Fair Office. The categories listed below will be judged by a panel of judges from Tulelake and Butte Valley. Each category will be judged on a 1 to 10 point system. ("1" being poor and "10" being outstanding).

- Current & Past Participation on Junior Fair Board
- Essay Questions
- Academic Achievement
- Communication Skills
- Social Responsibilities (School, Organizations, Fair, or other Activities)
