#### **GENERAL SHOW RULES**

1. This is a Jr. Livestock Show and classes are open to all junior exhibitors 5 through 19 years of age as of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019.
2. The entry fee is \$35 per animal when pre-entered. No refunds. The local show entry fee is \$25 per animal. Entries must be postmarked no later than Monday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>. The entry fees must accompany the official entry or a late fee of \$20 will be added.
3. Late entries will be charged an additional \$10. \$5 late fee for showmanship entries, late entries will be cash only.
4. There will be no limit on number of entries per exhibitor.
5. Barns will be open to receive entries after 10:00 AM on Friday, June 14<sup>th</sup>. All entries must be on the grounds and must be checked in by 9:00 Beef and Hogs and 12 noon Sheep & Boer Goats on Saturday, June 15<sup>th</sup>.
6. Bedding will be shavings. **No straw will be allowed!** Over night guest bedding will be available additional shavings will available for purchase at the show. There are no pre-assigned stalls. Exhibitors may choose their own tie area on a first come-first served basis.
7. All pens must be cleaned out before leaving the fairgrounds. If pens are left dirty exhibitor will be charged \$20/per pen/tie. These charges will be deducted from the exhibitor's premium check.
8. Beginner aged exhibitors may be assisted by an older exhibitor if assistance is required for safety/control purposes.
9. All persons showing must be clean and neatly attired. Collared shirts are MANDATORY. No T-Shirts or Scoop collared blouses allowed, NO EXCEPTION. (No uniforms required.)
10. Showmanship: \$10 entry fee per exhibitor. Classes will be in three age divisions: Junior-12 and under Intermediate-13-15, Senior-16 and over. The showmanship finals will be held at the conclusion of the show. Animal and Exhibitor must be entered in a class together to be eligible for Showmanship. Late entries into Showmanship: \$20 per exhibitor will only be accepted until 10AM, Saturday June 15<sup>th</sup>.
11. The Show Management reserves the right to change the show schedule and classes to improve the show.
12. Tulelake-Butte Valley Fair policy prohibits the use of alcohol on the grounds. No smoking will be allowed in the barns area. The show committee reserves the right to remove any competitor or spectator for any conduct in which the committee feels reflects poorly on the event.
13. All Prospect and Progress Market animals must be weighed. Classes will be divided after weigh-in by the Stateline Spectacular staff.

#### **SISKIYOU/MODOC COUNTY LOCAL SHOW:**

1. Exhibitors in this show must be a resident of Siskiyou or Modoc County.
2. To be eligible for entry in the local division, the exhibitor must have shown the animal in the "Open" Stateline Spectacular Jr. Livestock Show (excluding showmanship) earlier in the day.
3. Pre Registration: \$25 per animal per class. No Refunds. Entries must be postmarked no later than June 8th.
4. Late entries will be charged an additional \$10. Late entries will be cash only.
5. Beef, Sheep, Goat and Swine classes will be available in the Siskiyou/Modoc County Local Division. Classes will be divided depending upon the number of entries per division.
6. There will be no Siskiyou/Modoc County local showmanship contest.

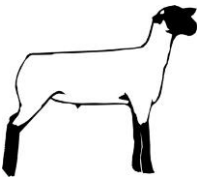

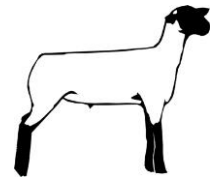

Prospect Steers (English followed by Black/Black X/AOC), Progress Steers (English followed by Black/Black X/AOC), Market Heifers, Registered Heifers (British followed by Continental followed by All Other Breeds), Commercial Heifers, Showmanship (Junior followed by Intermediate followed by Senior followed by Pee Wee Showmanship), Siskiyou/Modoc County Local Show (Steers followed by Heifers)

1. Class premiums will be paid to 4<sup>th</sup> place in each class. (Awarding 1<sup>st</sup> 40%, 2<sup>nd</sup> 25%, 3<sup>rd</sup> 20%, 4<sup>th</sup>15% of the 75% payout per Division, per Class.) Premium checks will be sent to the exhibitors no later than June 25<sup>th</sup> 2019.
2. Open to heifers born from 9/1/2017 through 10/31/18. Classes will be broken by age according to entries. Heifers must be accompanied by registration papers or a copy of transfer papers or an affidavit of transferee of registration papers from their National Breed Association in the 4-H, FFA or Independent members name as of the show date. There will be a commercial heifer class for all unregistered heifers.
3. Weigh-in will be from 6:30 - 9:00 a.m. **Late entries will be charged an additional \$20. Late entries will be cash only. No Exceptions.** Steers will be broken into two class divisions after weigh-in. Divisions will be: Prospect and Progress.
4. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Out of state entries must conform to all rules and regulations of interstate shipment to California.
5. All pens/ties must be cleaned out before leaving the fairgrounds. If pens are left dirty exhibitor will be charged \$20/per pen/tie. These charges will be deducted from the exhibitor's premium check.

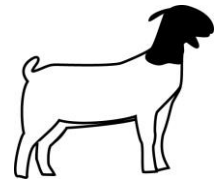
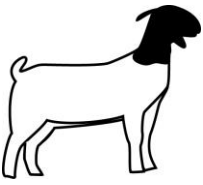

2. Animals must be slick sheared with no more than 10 days fleece prior to weigh-in. Market Lambs only.
3. Weigh backs may be asked for at the discretion of the judge.
4. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Out of state entries must conform to all rules and regulations of interstate shipment to California.
5. Any animal showing evidence of Sore-mouth, Foot-rot or Active Club Lamb Fungus will be asked to leave the fairgrounds immediately.
6. Weigh-in will be from 12:00 - 12:30 p.m. **Late entries will be charged an additional \$20. Late entries will be cash only. No Exceptions.**
7. Jackpot lambs must show lambs teeth.
8. Lambs will be broken into two class divisions after weigh-in. Divisions will be: Prospect, Progress.
9. Ewes must be born after January 1, 2018 and will be assigned to classes by the show committee based on age.
10. All pens must be cleaned out before leaving the fairgrounds. If pens are left dirty exhibitor will be charged \$20/per pen. These charges will be deducted from the exhibitor's premium check.
