The Tulelake Butte Valley Fair annual spring fundraising dinner and auction will be held Saturday, April 22, 2017 in the main exhibit building at the fairgrounds in Tulelake. Event tickets are \$30 for one; \$50 for two and \$300 for a table (includes dinner for eight, a bottle of wine and raffle ticket package).
