Quality Assurance & Ethics Training for Fair Exhibitors

The Tulelake Butte Valley Fair will be hosting a Quality Assurance & Ethics Training Clinic on Wednesday May 10th from 6 to 7 p.m. in the Arts and Crafts Building at the fairgrounds. All 4-H & FFA members, leaders and parents are welcome to attend.

The Tulelake Butte Valley Fair requires all 10A DAA resident 4-H and FFA livestock exhibitors who plan to sell an animal in the Jr. Livestock Auction to attend a quality assurance and ethics training course once every two years.

Exhibitors who are planning on showing as “Independents” are required to attend the class each year in order to qualify to show and sell at the Tulelake Butte Valley Fair.
